

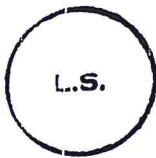

THE DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS (PUBLIC SERVICE) (SPECIFIED DEPARTMENTS)  
ORDER, 2002

By His Excellency The Most Honourable  
SIR HOWARD FELIX HANLAN COOKE, Mem-  
ber of the Order of the Nation, Knight  
Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished  
Order of Saint Michael and Saint George,  
Knight Grand Cross of the Royal Vic-  
torian Order, Commander of the Order of  
Distinction, Governor-General of Jamaica.

In exercise of the power conferred on the Governor-General by section 127(1) of the Constitution of Jamaica, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made on the advice of the Public Service Commission:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Delegations of Functions (Public Service) (Specified Departments) Order, 2002.

2. In this Order "officer" has the same meaning as in the Public Service Regulations 1961.

3. Subject to the provisions of section 127(4) of the Constitution of Jamaica, and of the Public Service Regulations, 1961, the powers of the Governor-General specified in the Schedule to this Order shall in relation to the respective offices and officers in the Department so specified, be exercisable by the appropriate authority so specified.

4. The powers referred to in paragraph 3 shall be exercised in accordance with the provisions of the Public Service Regulations, 1961.
