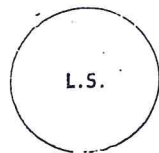

**THE CONSTITUTION OF JAMAICA**

THE DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS (PUBLIC SERVICE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1990

By His Excellency the Most Honourable Sir  
Florizel Augustus Glasspole, Order of the  
Nation, Knight Grand Cross of the Most  
Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and  
Saint George, Knight Grand Cross of the  
Royal Victorian Order, Commander of the  
Order of Distinction, Governor-General  
of Jamaica.

In exercise of the power conferred on the Governor-General by section 127 of the Constitution of Jamaica, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made on the advice of the Public Service Commission:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Delegation of Functions (Public Service) (Amendment) Order, 1990, and shall be read and construed as one with the Delegation of Functions (Public Service) Order, 1963 (hereinafter referred to as

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by deleting Item 5 thereof and substituting therefor the following under the appropriate headings:—

Officer or Office	Powers	Appropriate Authority
"5. Correctional Officer whose basic annual salary (whether fixed or on a scale) does not exceed the maximum rate of basic annual salary payable to Staff Warders	Minor offences—fine not exceeding \$200, and written reprimand	Superintendent of the correctional institution in which the Officer is employed."
