THE DELEGATION OF FUNCTIONS (PUBLIC SERVICE) (SPECIFIED
MINISTRY) ORDER, 2014

By His Excellency the Most Honourable Sir Patrick Linton Allen, Member of the Order of the Nation, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Order of Distinction, Knight of Grace of the Most Venerable Order of the Hospital of Saint John of Jerusalem, Governor-General of Jamaica.

In exercise of the power conferred on the Governor-General by section 127 (1) of the Constitution of Jamaica, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made on the advice of the Public Service Commission:—

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Delegation of Functions (Public Service) (Specified Ministry) Order, 2014.
- (2) In this Order “officer” has the same meaning as in the Public Service Regulations, 1961.
- (3) Subject to the provisions of section 127 (4) of the Constitution of Jamaica, and of the Public Service Regulations, 1961, the powers of the Governor-General specified in the Schedule to this Order shall, with effect from October 1, 2014, be exercisable by the Permanent Secretary, in relation to the offices and officers in the Ministry of National Security.
- (4) The powers referred to in Paragraph 3 shall be exercised in accordance with the provisions of the Public Service Regulations, 1961.
